Funding is available to qualified non-profit organizations and institutions that are tax-exempt. Program and project proposals will be accepted along with capital and equipment proposals.

Presentation Criteria

After reviewing all applications, **selected organizations** will be contacted to present their Heart to Heart to the North Simcoe Rotaract Club. This presentation is an additional opportunity to showcase your organization, tell us about anything that didn't fit within the scope of the application form, and how the funds from the 2026 Buttertart Trot would support your project, if you were to be the successful recipient.

The presentation is to be **no more than 10 minutes in length, and will take place on October 7, 2025.** If selected to present your Heart to Heart, you will be sent a presentation time slot for that evening. The presentations will be **hosted at the Route 93 Innovation Hub, located at 270 King Street, Midland Ontario**. If you will require additional resources for your presentation (i.e. laptop, Wi-Fi, etc.) please let us know in advance.

Selection Criteria

The North Simcoe Rotaract Club (NSRC) reserves the right to:

Select either one or multiple recipients for this funding; to partially fund a project; and to reject any or all of the applications for funding at the sole discretion of the North Simcoe Rotaract Club.

The parameters that will be taken into consideration include:

- Does your organization and project align with the mission and values of the NSRC?
- Does the project or proposal represent a contribution to one of NSRC's four main pillars?
- What is the intended impact of the project or proposal on the community?
- Proposed timelines
- Geographic location of the project/proposal















Your Role as a Recipient of Funding:

- Meet the Buttertart Trot Planning Committee
- Help support the success of the event through social media sharing
- Attend the Buttertart Trot Event on June 13, 2026

Additional Important Information

If selected, funding is committed only for proceeds from the 2026 Buttertart Trot event. If your application for funding is granted in whole or in part, you will be required to provide the following:

- An accounting of the funds received from the North Simcoe Rotaract Club, following the completion of the projects by the outlined dates.
- Agreement to publish, without limitation, details of any Rotaract donation to your project, in the media.
- You may be required to enter into a disclaimer agreement absolving the North Simcoe Rotaract Club from all liability for any action resulting from the use of Rotaract donated funds.
- Please be aware that we may choose to donate to more than one charity.
- If funds are diverted to more than one charity, income tax receipting will need to be discussed to ensure proper accordance with the Canada Revenue Agency (CRA) guidelines.
